#### Doe ex rel. Tarlow v. D.C.

Three women with intellectual disabilities from Washington, DC,
had surgeries they didn't want.

SELF DETERMINATION	The women wanted self- determination.
	Judge Kavanaugh's ruling said that people with disabilities don't have the right to make up their own minds about their bodies.
